Calf Crop is One of the Best

The calving season at James Creek Simmental went well. Every year brings anticipation of the previous years matings. This year was no exception. The 214 cow continues to produce remarkable calves. Her consistency is remarkable. Breed her to any bull and she will deliver. 214 is a top female in the breed, with WW & YW epd's in the top 1%. She has two exceptional ET heifers by Autobahn. Her natural calf, is a heifer by Knight Mr. T. We flushed her to a bull from Canada, MFI Whistler. He is a frame reducer and an extremely thick beef bull. We are eagerly waiting to see these calves.

We added two Full Fleckvieh heifers last year. One is a Romulus daughter (N37) from Indian Valley Ranch, Arkansas. The other is a BHL Mr. Regent daughter (N10) from Moore Farms, Alabama. We are very pleased to have these individuals in our breeding program. N37 is in the donor program and produced 25 embryos in her first flush. We are looking forward to the addition of N10 to the donor program in the near future.

In March we purchased a breeding share in IPU Bronson. Bronson is sired by PRL Houston and from an Antonius dam, Dora Lee Franchesca. Bronson has created excitement with Canadian breeders. To my knowledge we are the only ranch in the United States to have semen on this bull. We are really looking forward to these calves in February 2007.
